

Where to Buy a Binder

What is a chest binder?

A binder is a garment worn to compress chest tissue to give a flatter or masculine appearance.

Binders are safer than bandages for example, but should still be worn with care and caution. Chest binders may not be super comfortable, but they should not be painful either.

Tips when buying a binder

- Carefully check the sizing and measuring instructions as brands differ.
- Always read the health directions and washing instructions of each garment.
- Always check shipping totals and currency conversion if purchasing outside Australia.
- Check time frames for expected delivery dates as some products are custom made.
